The Ross County Sheriff's Office is currently investigating a missing person's case involving 20 year old Shasta Himelrick.

The vehicle that Mrs. Himelrick was driving was found abandoned on 12/26/2014 at approximately 7:15 a.m. at the intersection of Three Locks and Higby Roads in Souteastern Ross County.

Investigators have interviewed family members and friends. Mrs. Himelrick was last seen on 12/25/2014 in the early evening hours. Friends have reported having text communication with her at approximately 2:30 a.m. on 12/26/2014. Investigators found security video of her at a gas station in Chillicothe, Ohio on 12/26/2014 at approximately 3:15 a.m.

Mrs. Himelrick is approximately 5'4" tall, between 120 to 150 lbs., blonde hair, and green eyes. She was last known to be wearing gray sweat pants, a pink hooded sweatshirt with a logo on the front. She has tattoos one on her right bicep area that is predominately red in color
